Our warm-up centre

Our emergency warm-up centre is located at the community hall in Freeland. The warm-up centre will be activated by the Municipal Emergency Measures Organization during emergencies that require temporary shelter for residents.

This past year we installed an emergency power generator. Partial funding and substantial support for this project was provided by the PEI Office of Public Safety and Public Safety Canada's Joint Emergency Preparedness Program (JEPP).

Our municipality thanks all of our supporters, especially the Freeland Women's Institute, for helping us realize our emergency preparedness objectives.
