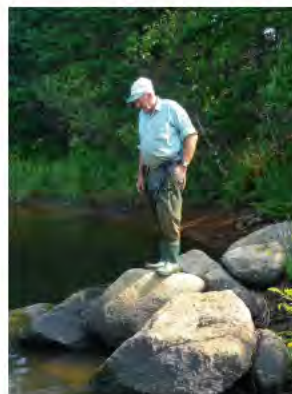
### Our Work

- Constructed sediment trap: Foxley River
- Presented watershed seminars: 4H Environmental Badge Program and West Isle School - Grade 11
- Planted 800 trees/shrubs
- Ongoing habitat restoration in seven area rivers
- Created recreational/educational trail at MacDonald's river (ongoing)
- Managed beavers and alders
